

HOGE FENTON WELCOMES BACK HONORABLE CATHARINE B. BAKER





Assemblywoman Catharine B. Baker represented the 16th Assembly District from 2014 through 2018. She is returning to Hoge Fenton as Special Counsel, where she advises businesses and non-profits.

During her legislative tenure, Catharine developed a reputation as an independent, bipartisan voice in the Legislature, fostering collaboration that led to breakthroughs in significant legislation, particularly on transportation, the environment, and government accountability.

Significant legislation included the creation of Valley Link, to construct a commuter rail connection between the Central Valley and Bay Area, and a new parking garage at the Dublin/Pleasanton BART station.
